Please respect all Park rules in the following pages to preserve the relationship between equestrians and MV and help ensure the future of eventing at Campbell Valley.





Fire risk is high at the Park due to the dry weather.

Please follow these rules carefully, otherwise MV Parks

may have to shut down the entire event.

- 1. NO idling your vehicle. This creates hot spots under the vehicle very quickly.
  - 2. NO SMOKING ANYWHERE ON THE PROPERTY.
- 3. NO Cooking Outside only inside a camper or RV. ABSOLUTELY NO exceptions for any kind of cooking device. Please don't ask. The Bread and Cheese Food Truck will be on site all weekend, or food delivery services will deliver to the Park.
  - 4. NO kind of propane or any other kind of campfire device.
- 5. NO generators sitting on the ground. You can put it in your truck bed or bring a piece of plywood or something to set it on away from the grass.
- 6. Have a fire extinguisher or bucket of water ready near your unit at all times.
- 7. Keep your vehicles at least 10 feet from the tree line. Trailers are OK backed up to trees.
- 8. Try to minimize driving vehicles in and out of the camping area as much as possible.

We hope that everyone will be able to abide by these rules and enjoy the competition!



# **PARKING**

- No Horse Trials competitors, spectators, volunteers, or anyone affiliated with the event to park at the red barn.
  - This lot MUST be left for regular park users.
- **Horse trailers** to the upper lot by the XC field-absolutely no cars here!
  - Please back in trailers head-to-head to ensure everyone can fit.
  - Do not unload horses onto new bike lane. All bike lanes are closed to horses.
- Cars to the grass lot across from PRDA.
  - If you have limited mobility please contact
     Diane at 604-377-2852 to get a parking pass for the red barn lot

Thank you everyone for following these parking rules to make sure all of the competitors have a place to park!

Spectator lots will be locked at 8pm. Don't get locked in!








- Dogs are welcome, but keep them on leash and under a watchful eye. Loose or barking dogs can create very dangerous situations.
- Horses have the right of way at all times and riders are focused on their task so be sure to stay out of the way. Sudden movements may startle the horse.
- Outside assistance is not allowed for the competitors while they are in the ring or on course so cheer them on, but don't offer any advice. They could be eliminated.

- Please no bathing of horses, water is in short supply and has to be trucked in.
- Purchase shavings tickets at the office, and pick up your shavings from Nora at stabling.
  - \$15 per bag
- To receive your stall deposit at the end of the event, please leave stall clean and dry:
  - o no shavings, hay, or manure
  - o no mud from urine
  - o no baling twine on fencing
- No Sunday night stays unless organized prior to the event.


Reminder to please not sit on or climb over any XC jumps.

#### **My First Horse Trials**
